♣ **Prizes:** \$6,700 based on 120 paid entries, otherwise proportional. Prizes will be split among tied players. Unrated players may not win more than the third-place prize amount.

Time control: 40/90, SD/30; +30 except 2-day schedule rounds 1 and 2 are G/75; d5

♣ **U2100, U1700, U1300 Sections**

Players must be current USCF members. Section assignments and pairings will be based on March 2019 official USCF ratings, except that unofficial ratings, if available, will be used for players who are officially unrated. Players may choose to play up but may not play up more than one section.

Time control: G/120; d5 all rounds

Schedule: 6 rounds are scheduled: **1** Fri 7 pm, **2** Sat 9:30 am, **3** Sat 2 pm, **4** Sat 7 pm, **5** Sun 9:30 am, **6** Sun 2 pm.

Players must select one round of the six for a zero-point bye so that all players play a five-round schedule. See www.chesscincinnati.com/cincinnati-open for details.

Players should bring pieces, boards and clocks. Scoresheets will be available at the tournament.

♣ **Optional Byes:** Players may elect to take one or two half-point byes, but must commit by 5:00 pm Saturday. For the U2100, U1700 and U1300 sections, these byes are additional to the required zero-point bye.

Entry Fee: \$109 in advance, \$120 onsite, \$50 to re-enter (Re-entry counts as one-half paid entry for prizes.)
GMs, IMs, WGMs, WIMs: No entry fee; \$109 less any applicable discount will be deducted from any prize won.

Entry Fee Loyalty Discount:

- *A List Discount:* If you played in the 2018 Cincinnati Open, you may take a \$10 discount.
- *B List Discount:* If you did not play in the Cincinnati Open in 2018 but played in any year from 2012 through 2017, you may take a \$5 discount.

To confirm your eligibility for either discount, check the A and B Lists at www.chesscincinnati.com/cincinnati_open.

Rebate for Recruiting New Players: Any player who plays in the 2019 Cincinnati Open is eligible for a rebate for recruiting a *new player* to play in the Cincinnati Open. Cincinnati Scholastic Chess will pay the player a \$15 rebate for each identified *new player* whom he or she recruits. A *new player* is one who (a) did not play in any Cincinnati Open from 2012 through 2018, (b) enters the 2019 Cincinnati Open with the payment of a normal entry fee, and (c) plays at least one round of the tournament. To confirm whether a player is eligible to be recruited as a *new player*, check the A and B Lists at www.chesscincinnati.com/cincinnati_open.

A player may recruit any number of new players, but the total amount rebated will not exceed the amount of the entry fee actually paid by the recruiting player. To be credited with recruiting a new player, a player must notify the tournament organizers of the name and USCF ID of each new player recruited (enter "new" as the USCF ID for anyone who has not yet purchased a USCF membership). This notification can be provided on the mail-in or online entry form when entering the tournament, or by email to info@chesscincinnati.com. Each recruited new player must likewise indicate on his or her entry form the name and USCF ID of the player who recruited him or her.

Rebates will be paid to players at the tournament when all criteria have been confirmed. We will pay the rebate for each instance where we can match recruiter and recruit referrals. Only one player will be credited as the recruiter for each new player recruited. No rebates will be paid for recruits who do not enter the tournament or withdraw before playing any rounds.

Advance Registration

Onsite Registration

On Saturday, March 30, 8:00-10:00 am, players may enter only as specified below.

- Championship Section 2-day schedule
- Championship Section 3-day schedule with a half-point bye for round 1 (Friday, 7 pm)
- U2100, U1700, U1300 Sections with a zero point bye for round 1 (Friday, 7 pm) and a half-point bye for round 2 (Saturday, 9:30 am) *Players who enter on Saturday morning will not be paired to play in the round at 9:30 am Saturday even if they enter before 9:30 am.*
