Sections and Prizes: Nine sections. \$17,000 prize pool based on 270 paid entries. Players may play up but not more than two sections. Unrated players may play in any UNDER section but may not play in any FIDE section, and may win no more than the second-place prize amount in their section.

FIDE Sections – FIDE Elite (no ceiling), FIDE Expert (U2201) and FIDE Class (U2001) sections are FIDE rated except for rounds 1 and 2 of the 2-day schedule. Players must be current USCF members and have a FIDE Identification Number (FIN). Players with no USCF Regular rating must have a FIDE standard rating of 1579 or higher (1464 or higher if under the age of 18) to play in a FIDE section.

Time control: 40/90,SD/30;+30 except 2-day schedule rounds 1 and 2 are G/75;d5.

Schedules: 3-Day: Fri 7:00 pm, Sat 11:00 am & 6:00 pm, Sun 9:30 am & 3:00 pm

2-Day: Sat 11:00 am, 2:30 pm & 6:00 pm, Sun 9:30 am & 3:00 pm

The organizers will provide all pieces, boards, clocks and scoresheets for the FIDE sections.

UNDER Sections – Seniors U1801, U1801, U1601, U1401, U1201, U1001. Players must be current USCF members. Official USCF Regular ratings as of April 1, 2025 will be used, except that unofficial ratings, if available, will be used for players who are officially unrated or for players who choose to use an unofficial rating higher than their official rating.

Time control: G/110;d5 all rounds.

Schedule: 1 Fri 7:00 pm, 2 Sat 9:30 am, 3 Sat 2:00 pm, 4 Sat 7:00 pm, 5 Sun 9:30 am, 6 Sun 2:00 pm.

Players must select one round of the six for a zero-point bye so that all players play a five-round schedule. See www.chesscincinnati.com/cincinnati.open/ for details.

Players are responsible for bringing pieces, boards and clocks. Scoresheets will be available at the tournament.

Optional Byes: Players may elect to take one or two half-point byes, but must commit by 5:00 pm Saturday, April 12. For the UNDER sections, these byes are additional to the required zero-point bye.

Onsite entry – \$150 on Friday, April 11, 5:00–6:00 pm and Saturday, April 12, 8:00–10:00 am.
